- Lira Town College is located on Inomo Road, Opposite Stanbic Bank. It is found in Lira Town College village, Te-obia parish, Central division, Lira Municipality.
- It is one of the two government aided schools in Lira municipality, the other being Lango College.

- It was started in 1965, and commissioned by the former President, Dr. Apollo Milton Obote.
- Currently, the college has a student enrollment of 2700 and has 90 teachers.
- Every term, students are subjected two sets of exams: Mid Term exams and End of Term exams.
